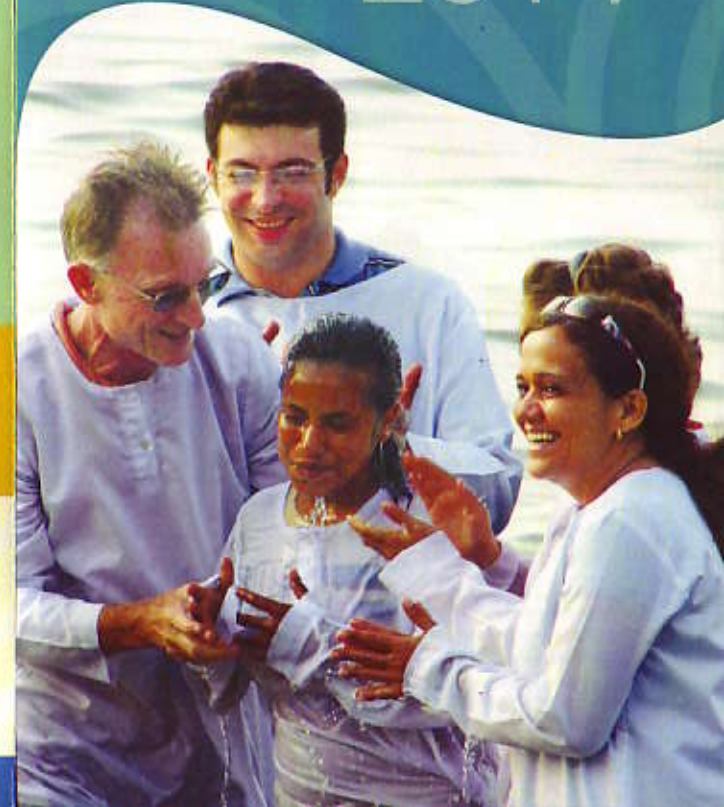

How Will They Hear? Phase II

How Will They Hear? (HWTH?) is NMSI's capital campaign, launched in early 2008 in order to send out 400 new missionaries by 2014 (based on our growth rate). As a Christian missionary training and sending ministry, more people are coming to us with a call and a passion to be involved in missionary service than we have the capacity to house, train and send.

HWTH? is a direct response to the apostle Paul's question in Romans 10:14, "And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent?". The staff and training facilities at NMSI's Center for Global Outreach do just that—prepare and send out those who will tell others about Jesus. In fact, our mission is to foster the emergence and growth of Jesus following communities and to place people in fields of service to minister God's love. Will you join us?

NMSI currently has three missionary training programs per year. Our campus contains 16 homes and apartments, but one of them sustained fire damage and can't be used, and the other is a dilapidated former drug house. They both need to be demolished and be replaced by new two-story residences.

NMSI has short-term, long-term and volunteer service opportunities.

The Goal

The goal of **HWTH?** Phase II is to raise \$400,000 over the period of one year. These funds will be used to rebuild two unusable homes or to purchase available properties while prices are low. One of the new homes will allow us to host short-term teams, which is vital to our desire to keep construction and renovation costs low. This will have a direct connection to our ability to train and send additional missionaries around the world.
